Description of Clubs: Summer Term 2026

Gardening Club

We will plant and grow vegetables and flowers. We will maintain the vegetable patch and planters around school.

Cricket Club

We build batting, bowling and fielding skills through fun, competitive match play while developing teamwork and game awareness.

Running Club

Running club has a maximum of 16 pupils. Making the most of Ilkley Moor and its surroundings, we run a variety of routes with the aim of gradually increasing distance each week.

Rambling Club

Tennis Club

Tennis club has a maximum capacity of 12 children, offering a great opportunity to play competitive matches while developing basic shots and building an understanding of more advanced technical and tactical aspects of the game.

Knitting Club
